ACID DESCALING AND SANITISING DETERGENT

Acid sanitising effect detergent specifically for removing limescale deposits from enamelled surfaces, taps, stoneware and ceramics.

HOW TO USE

Dilute the product in water to the recommended concentration. Clean the surfaces. Rinse thoroughly.

DILUTION

3% - 5 % (300 ml to 500 ml in 10 L of water) For stubborn deposits on hard surfaces (stoneware, ceramics, concrete) dilute to 10% (1 L every 10 L of water).
